INTRODUCTION

- Treatment principles in neuropelveology: causal vs symptomatic therapy
- Stepwise approach: from conservative to invasive

MEDICAL TREATMENT

- Pharmacological treatments & adjunctive therapies
- Treatment of comorbidities

SURGICAL TREATMENT- PRERECORDED VIDEOS

- Anatomical dissection of the pelvic autonomic nerves & plexus on cadaver
- Laparoscopic dissection of the sacral plexus, sciatic and pudendal nerves on a female cadaver
- Laparoscopic exploration/decompression sacral plexus/lumbal plexus
- Laparoscopic treatment endometriosis of the sciatic nerve & sacral plexus
- Laparoscopic treatment pelvic nerves tumors
- Laparoscopic nerves release after colpopexy and herniorrhaphia

- Pain management and supportive therapy

ONLINE EXAMEN - MULTIPLE CHOICES & CLINICAL CASES

- ISON Level 2 Certification with Official ISON Diploma

- In case of failure, candidates may apply for one additional attempt after payment of a reduced re-examination fee (EUR 250).
- If a candidate fails the exam twice, they must re-register for the full program, attend all course sessions again, and pay the full registration fee before being eligible for another examination.
